


<p><u>Main and Collector Roads</u> Continuous plowing. Thru lanes plowed to bare pavement up to 24 hours after the end of the storm.</p>	<p><u>Main and Collector Roads</u> Continuous plowing. Thru lanes plowed to bare pavement up to 24 - 36 hours after the end of the storm.</p>	<p><u>Main and Collector Roads</u> Continuous plowing. Thru lanes plowed to bare pavement up to 24 - 48 hours after the end of the storm. Expect narrowed and/or blocked lanes due to accumulations.</p>	<p><u>Main and Collector Roads</u> Continuous plowing. Thru lanes plowed to bare pavement up to 36 - 60 hours after the end of the storm. Expect narrowed and/or blocked lanes due to accumulations.</p>	<p><u>Main and Collector Roads</u> Continuous salting and/or sanding until road conditions improve. Bridges, ramps, underpasses freeze first. Possible traffic signal outages and tree limbs in roadway.</p>
<p><u>Residential Streets</u> Plowing equipment will enter the residential streets after the main and collector roads are completed. Streets will be passable* (but not cleared to bare pavement) up to 36 hours after the end of the storm.</p>	<p><u>Residential Streets</u> Plowing equipment will enter the residential streets after the main and collector roads are completed. Streets will be passable* (but not cleared to bare pavement) 2 - 3 days after the end of the storm.</p>	<p><u>Residential Streets</u> Plowing equipment will enter the residential streets after the main and collector roads are completed. Streets will be passable* (but not cleared to bare pavement) 3 - 4 days after the end of the storm.</p>	<p><u>Residential Streets</u> Plowing equipment will enter the residential streets after the main and collector roads are completed. Streets will be passable* (but not cleared to bare pavement) 4 - 6 days after the end of the storm.</p>	<p><u>Residential Streets</u> Sanding and/or salting begins, as needed, up to 24 hours after the storm ends. Possible traffic signal outages and tree limbs in roadway.</p>

•Passable means that the road may be snow packed, only one travel lane is accessible, and all-weather tires are a must. During a blizzard or State of Emergency, Anne Arundel County forces, even supplemented with contractors, may **not** meet the published Travel Guide's levels of service.
