Classes start on Monday, February 12th. We will be offering a wide range of class times and dates at our Glen Burnie training site through Saturday, April 20th.</p> <p>After April 20th, training classes will not be offered in Glen Burnie due to the start of canvassing and Early Voting. Starting Monday, April 22 training classes will be held at the Pip Moyer Recreation Center, 273 Hilltop Lane, Annapolis.</p> <p>We will email you the Training Class Scheduling Link at the end of January so that you will be able to pick a date and time that works best with your schedule.</p> <p>The Chief Judges and the Pollbook/Same Day Registration Judges will both need to attend two (2) training classes. The Provisional Judges and the Voting Operations Judges will each attend one (1) training class. The compensation for attending training class is \$50.00 for each class.</p> |

Changes in the Payroll Requirements for 2024

The 2024 Election Judge Payroll process is changing and with the changes come new requirements.

NEW: Payroll for the 2024 Election Judge Cycle will be direct deposited into your bank account 6 to 8 weeks after the election. Payment will now be processed by the Anne Arundel County Office of Personnel.

To make the changes to the process, we have new payroll forms that need to be completed by all election judges.

The new required forms include: Direct Deposit Authorization and a completed I-9 form, with the correct documentation. The MD507 and W-4 Withholding Forms, as in the past, are also required.

Reserve Judges are trained in one of the 4 election judge positions and are dispatched on election morning from a central location to a polling place in need of assistance. The judge will stay at his/her assigned polling place for the remainder of election day.

Sugar Cookie Fudge Recipe

Ingredients:

3 Cups white chocolate chips

1 1/4 cup sugar cookie mix (you can use Betty Crocker sugar cookie mix)

1 tablespoon unsalted butter

1 can (14 ounces) sweetened condensed milk

1 teaspoon pure vanilla extract

3/4 cup holiday sprinkles (divided)

Directions:

Line a 9x9 square baking pan or 8X 8 with parchment paper and spray with cooking spray

combine white chocolate chips, sugar cookie mix, butter, and sweetened condensed milk in a medium sized saucepan and heat over medium heat. once the mixture is melted and smooth, remove from heat and add the vanilla and holiday sprinkles (about 1/2 cup).

Pour mixture into the prepared pan and sprinkle with remaining holiday sprinkles.

Refrigerate for about an hour or until hard before cutting into squares.
