These Programs Can Help With
Prescription Drug Costs

Extra Help

Social Security Extra Help assists in paying for your Medicare Part D premiums, co-pays, and deductibles. The amount of help depends on your income and assets.

Income/Asset Limits:

If Single:

- Income is less than **\$1353.75/mo. (\$16,245/yr.)**
- Assets are less than **\$12,510**

If Married:

- Combined income is less than **\$1821.25/mo. (\$21,855/yr.)**
- Total assets are less than **\$25,010**

SPDAP

With the Senior Prescription Drug Assistance Program (SPDAP), the State of Maryland pays up to \$25 toward the cost of your Medicare Part D premium.

Income Limit (No Asset Limit)

If Single:

- Income is less than **\$2,707.50/mo. (\$32,490/yr.)**

If Married:

- Combined income is less than **\$3,642.50/mo. (\$43,710/yr.)**
