SUMMER SESSION CLASS REGISTRATION

Annapolis, MD (April 7, 2011) -- Registration for the summer session classes offered by Anne Arundel Community College begins April 18, 2011, at the seven senior activity centers operated by the Anne Arundel County Department of Aging and Disabilities. Classes begin July 5, 2010.

To obtain a class schedule, visit the senior center you wish to attend or go online at www.aacounty.com/aging and click on a senior activity center for its list of courses. Early registration is encouraged to avoid class cancellations. Once you are registered, the college will mail you confirmation.

There are several ways to register for the AACC classes held at the senior centers.

- In person at one of AACC's three campus locations: Arnold, Glen Burnie Town Center, and AACC at Arundel Mills.

Mail a registration form to Continuing Education and Workforce Development-CALT 115, 101 College Parkway, Arnold, MD 21012.

- In person at your local senior center.

Tuition is waived for those 60 and older but there is an administrative fee of \$40 payable to AACC. This one-time fee covers all courses taken for the semester. Seniors ages 55-59 must pay the \$40 administrative fee plus \$40 per course. Some classes may have an additional fee for supplies or a text book.

The seven senior activity centers also offer non-college courses. Visit your senior center to review the available courses. Some new classes this semester include computer keyboarding, home computer data organization, Google tools, choral masterpieces, timely topics, America's first ladies, opera appreciation, Western European civilization, and history of piracy on the Chesapeake Bay among many others.
