### Adaptive Summer Sports Camp

Annapolis, MD (May 25, 2011) – The Anne Arundel County Commission on Disability Issues encourages youth of all abilities who are looking for a fun sports-oriented experience to check out Page 31 of the Summer Program Guide from the Department of Recreation and Parks.

A Summer Sports Camp program is scheduled for the Waterford Park Freedom Field, 830 Pasadena Road, Pasadena, from July 5 to July 29.

The non-competitive program for all levels promotes exercise and fun and is a combination of activities from games on the fields to play in the playground and in the park. Youth should bring snacks or bag lunches and dress comfortably. Only sneakers are allowed on the field.

Session 1 is “Sticks and Bats” and focuses on baseball/softball, lacrosse and hockey. Session 2 is “Balls and Goals” and focuses on soccer, flag football and kickball. Session 1 for ages 6-10 and ages 10-14 is from 4 to 8 p.m. July 5 to July 15. Session 2 for ages 6-10 and ages 10-14 is from 4 to 8 p.m. July 18 to July 29. Session 1 costs \$205; Session 2 costs \$240.

No bus service is available for this camp, and there will not be a nurse for medical protocol or medicine administration.
