Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program**

Annapolis, MD (June 14, 2011) – Distribution of the Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program checks will begin in July at senior activity centers located in Anne Arundel County. The checks are good for the purchase of fresh produce at the county farmers' markets.

Senior citizens must be at least 60 years or age and meet certain income guidelines. Seniors will verify their eligibility at the distribution points. Checks will be available on the following sites and dates:
