Arnold Center announces 2012 bus trips

Annapolis, MD (Dec. 20, 2011) – Seniors who are members of any of the county’s seven senior centers can sign up for bus trips offered by the Arnold Senior Activity Center during 2012. Membership is free and is for any senior age 55 and older.

Reservations are being taken now for a trip to Toby’s Dinner Theatre in Baltimore for a performance of “Smokey Joe’s Café” on March 15. The cost is \$64 and includes transportation, performance and lunch. The center also is planning a trip to Rainbow Dinner Theatre in Paradise, Pa., for a performance of “Things My Mother Taught Me” on Aug. 2. The cost is \$77. The center also will take seniors to see “Miracle of Christmas” at the Sight and Sound Millennium Theater in Strasburg, Pa., on Dec. 12 for \$107.

Additional trip locations in 2012 include Hillwood Museum and Gardens in Washington, D.C.; Peddler’s Village Strawberry Festival in Lahaska, Pa.; the Newseum and lunch at Phillip’s Flagship Restaurant in Washington, D.C.; St. Michael’s, Maryland; a cruise on the *Dorothy Megan* and a crab feast in Hurlock; and “Christmas on the Bay” in Annapolis and Grasonville. A mystery trip is scheduled for Oct. 18.
