### **Pascal Senior Activity Center announces trips**

Annapolis, MD (Jan. 3, 2012) – The Pascal Senior Activity Center at 125 Dorsey Road in Glen Burnie has announced its trip schedule for 2012, including musical theater, casino, and museum ventures.

Deposits are being taken now for trips such as the performance of “Let’s Murder Marsha” on March 7 at the Rainbow Dinner Theater in Lancaster, Pa. The cost is \$72 and includes transportation, food, and show. The bus leaves Sawmill Creek Park at 9 a.m. and returns at 5 p.m. The senior center also plans another trip to Lancaster on March 31 to the American Music Theatre presenting the Oak Ridge Boys. The \$100 fee includes transportation, food, and performance. The bus leaves the park at 10 a.m. and returns at 7:30 p.m.

Additional trips to musical theater presentations are planned throughout the year. Seniors also can take trips to area casinos in March, May, July and September,

Several day trips are on the schedule including a riverboat cruise, a visit to the ceramics store in Pennsylvania, a C&O Canal boat tour, a visit to Tangier Island, a tour of the Mummer’s Museum in Philadelphia, a stop at the Shenandoah caverns and an American Celebration, and a crab feast. In November seniors can see a special attraction called “The War Came by Train” at the B&O Museum in Baltimore during the 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration of the Civil War. The trip schedule concludes with a holiday show by The Talent Machine in Annapolis.
