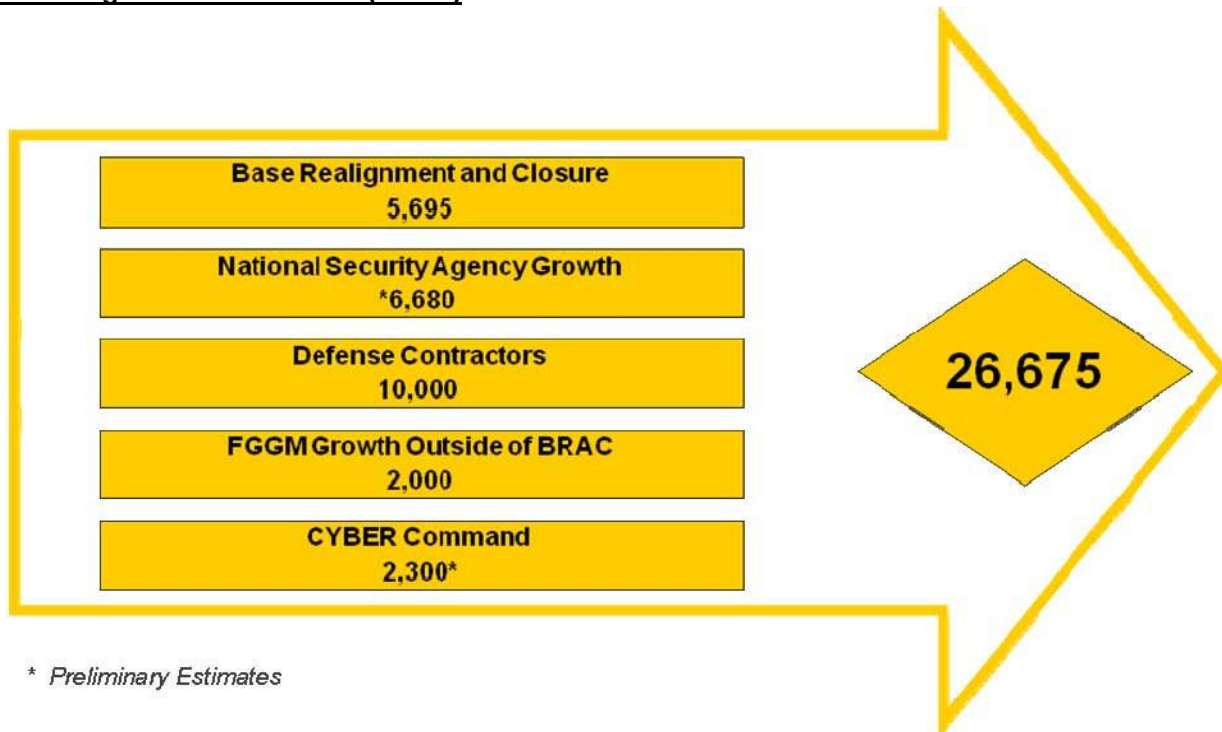

### Fort Meade Growth (2007-2015)

There are currently five major components to Fort Meade's growth:

- **Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC)**
- **FGGM Growth Outside of BRAC**
- **National Security Agency**
- **Defense Contractors**
- **U.S. Cyber Command**

### Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC)

The 2005 BRAC transferred three organizations to Fort Meade. These organizations must be in place by September 2011.

- **Defense Information Systems Agency (DISA): 4,272 Positions**
  - Construction on Schedule
  - Begin Phased Relocation: 11 January 2011
  - Complete Construction: February 2011
- **Defense Media Agency (DMA): 663 Positions**
  - Construction on schedule
  - Beneficial Occupancy: April 2011
- **Defense Adjudication Co-location: 760 Positions**
  - Construction on schedule
  - Beneficial Occupancy: April 2011

## **National Security Agency**

To meet NSA's continually evolving requirements, the Department of Defense has proposed to construct and operate 1.8 million square feet of new consolidated facilities for Intelligence Community Use. The new facilities would be built on Fort Meade in the near term (2012-2014) and provide administrative functions for up to 6,500 personnel. The complex would include a data center and associated administrative space including a steam and chilled water plant, water storage tower, electrical substations and generator facilities capable of supporting the new operational complex.

## **United States Cyber Command**

The United States Cyber Command was officially activated on May 21, 2010 at Fort Meade, Maryland and is expected to reach full operational readiness later in 2010. The mission of the US Cyber Command is to coordinate computer-network defense and direct U.S. cyber-attack operations. The Cyber Command is expected to employ a national workforce of about 20,000 employees, military, federal civil service, and defense contractors. A final breakout of employees expected for Fort Meade is not yet firm.
