A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE concerning: Current Expense Budget – Transfer of Funds  
2 – Chief Administrative Officer – Reserve for Contingencies - Board of License  
3 Commissioners  
4

5 FOR the purpose of transferring an appropriation of funds from the Reserve for  
6 Contingencies of the Chief Administrative Officer to the Board of License  
7 Commissioners; and making this Ordinance an emergency measure.  
8

9 BY amending: Current Expense Budget  
10

11 WHEREAS, under Section 711(a) of the Charter, upon recommendation of the  
12 County Executive, the County Council may transfer funds between offices,  
13 departments, institutions, boards, commissions or other agencies of the County  
14 government and within the same fund of the Current Expense Budget; and

16 WHEREAS, under § 712 of the Charter, upon recommendation of the County  
17 Executive, the County Council may make supplementary appropriations from  
18 contingent funds, provided that the Controller shall first certify in writing that such  
19 funds are available for such appropriation; and  
20

21 WHEREAS, the County Executive has made a recommendation that funds from the  
22 FY2009 appropriation to Chief Administrative Officer, Reserve for Contingencies,  
23 be transferred to the Board of License Commissioners; and

24 WHEREAS, the Controller has certified in writing that such funds are available for

1           appropriation; now, therefore,

3           SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*

4           That the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, be and it is hereby

5           amended by transferring the appropriation of funds from Chief Administrative Office -

6           General Fund Appropriation, Reserve for Contingencies, in the amount of \$47,000 to the

7           Board of License Commissioners – General Fund Appropriation, Contractual Services.

9           SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an

10          emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,

11          health, safety, welfare, and property and being passed by the affirmative vote of five

12          members of the County Council, the same shall take effect from the date it becomes law.
