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A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: County Retirement and Pension System Board of Trustees  
2  
3 FOR the purpose of removing the requirement that the five members of the County and  
4 Retirement System Board of Trustees who are plan participants be members of the  
5 classified service.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments: § 5-2-105(a)  
8 Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended)

10 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*  
11 That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (1985, as amended) read as follows:

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13 **ARTICLE 5 PENSIONS**

15 **TITLE 2. COUNTY RETIREMENT AND PENSION SYSTEM**

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17 **5-2-105. Board of Trustees – Membership.**

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19 (a) **Generally.** The Board consists of the following 13 Trustees:

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21 (1) the Chief Administrative Officer, ex officio;

23 (2) the Controller, ex officio;

1 (3) the Personnel Officer, ex officio;

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3 (4) the Budget Officer, ex officio;

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5 (5) the Director of Public Works, or other appointed official of the County as  
6 appointed by the County Executive, ex officio;

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8 (6) five Trustees[ who are members of the classified service]:

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10 (i) one of whom is a participant in the Fire Service Retirement Plan;

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12 (ii) one of whom is a participant in the Police Service Retirement Plan and a  
13 member of FOP Lodge 70;

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15 (iii) one of whom is a participant in the Detention Officers' and Deputy Sheriffs'  
16 Retirement Plan;

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18 (iv) one of whom is a participant in the Employees' Retirement Plan and a  
19 member of either Local 582 or Local 2563 of the American Federation of State, County, and  
20 Municipal Employees AFL-CIO (affiliated with Maryland Public Employees' Council 67);  
21 and

23 (v) one of whom is a participant in the Employees' Retirement Plan and is not a  
24 member of a certified employee organization; and

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26 (7) three Trustees who are residents of the County, are not employees of the County  
27 or participants in any of the plans, and are knowledgeable in the administration and  
28 operation of pension systems and trust funds.

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30 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days  
31 from the date it becomes law.
