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A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Subdivision and Development – Adequate School  
2 Facilities – School Utilization Chart

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4 FOR the purpose of adopting a new School Utilization Chart and providing for an  
5 effective date of the School Utilization Chart.

7 WHEREAS, § 17-5-201(b) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as  
8 amended) requires that the Planning and Zoning Officer may not give final  
9 approval to development that does not pass the tests for adequate public facilities;  
10 and

12 WHEREAS, § 17-5-501 of the Anne Arundel County Code provides that a  
13 development passes the test for adequate school facilities if each public  
14 elementary, middle, and high school is designated as “open” on the School  
15 Utilization Chart described in § 17-5-502 for the geographical attendance areas  
16 for the development in the third school year after the school year in which the  
17 determination is being made; and

19 WHEREAS, § 17-5-502 requires the Planning and Zoning Officer to prepare a  
20 school utilization chart based on enrollments projected by the Board of Education  
21 and capacities as determined by the Board of Education and to submit the school  
22 utilization chart for approval by ordinance of the County Council; now therefore,

1       SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County,*  
2 *Maryland,* That the School Utilization Chart, a copy of which is attached to this  
3 Ordinance as ~~Exhibit A~~ Exhibit A1, is hereby approved and shall take effect on the same  
4 date this Ordinance takes effect.

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6       SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days  
7 from the date it becomes law.
