8 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County,*
9 *Maryland,* That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as

14 **TITLE 3. PARKING, NON RESIDENTIAL OUTDOOR LIGHTING AND**

17 **18-3-306. Temporary signs.**

19 (b) **Temporary directional signs.** A maximum of six temporary directional signs of
20 no more than three square feet in area or three feet in height are allowed per event or
21 destination, with a double-faced sign counting as one sign. A temporary directional sign
22 shall be self-supporting and may be posted only on weekends between [3:00 p.m] 8:00
23 A.M. on Friday and 9:00 a.m. on the following Monday or between 9:00 a.m. on County,
24 State, or federal holidays and 9:00 a.m. on the following day. Temporary directional
25 signs may be placed within a County right-of-way if the signs are located at least three
26 feet from any curbed or paved area.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS indicate new matter added to existing law.
[Brackets] indicate matter stricken from existing law.

1 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Ordinance shall take effect
2 45 days from the date it becomes law.
