A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Water System and Wastewater System Capital Facility
2 Connection Charges

3
4 FOR the purpose of amending the capital facility connection charges for connections to the
5 County's water system and the County's wastewater system; allowing the County
6 Executive to set the capital facility connection charges for connections to the County's
7 water system and the County's wastewater system in future fiscal years within certain
8 limits; and generally relating to the capital facility connection charges for connections to
9 the County's water system and the County's wastewater system.

11 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments: § 13-5-813(d) and (f)
12 Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended)

14 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*
15 That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (1985, as amended) read as follows:

21 **13-5-813. Water and wastewater system connection charges and assessments.**

23 (d) **Water system capital facility connection charge.**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS indicate new matter added to existing law.
[Brackets] indicate matter stricken from existing law.

1 (1) For connections to the County's water system, the capital facility connection
2 charge for each equivalent dwelling unit is [\$4,500] \$4,800.

4 (2) FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2010, AND FOR EACH FISCAL YEAR
5 THEREAFTER, THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE SHALL SET THE CAPITAL FACILITY CONNECTION
6 CHARGE FOR EACH EQUIVALENT DWELLING UNIT IN AN AMOUNT THAT SHALL NOT
7 INCREASE MORE THAN 5% FROM THE AMOUNT SET FOR THE PREVIOUS FISCAL YEAR. ANY
8 INCREASE THAT IS MORE THAN 5% FROM THE AMOUNT SET FOR THE PREVIOUS FISCAL YEAR
9 SHALL BE SET BY ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL.

11 **(f) Wastewater system capital facility connection charge.**

12
13 (1) For connections to the County's wastewater system, the capital facility connection
14 charge for each equivalent dwelling unit is [\$7,000] \$8,400.

15
16 (2) FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2010, AND FOR EACH FISCAL YEAR
17 THEREAFTER, THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE SHALL SET THE CAPITAL FACILITY CONNECTION
18 CHARGE FOR EACH EQUIVALENT DWELLING UNIT IN AN AMOUNT THAT SHALL NOT
19 INCREASE MORE THAN 5% FROM THE AMOUNT SET FOR THE PREVIOUS FISCAL YEAR. ANY
20 INCREASE THAT IS MORE THAN 5% FROM THE AMOUNT SET FOR THE PREVIOUS FISCAL YEAR
21 SHALL BE SET BY ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL.

23 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Ordinance shall take effect on July 1,
24 2009.
