A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Grant-In-Aid Program

3 FOR the purpose of removing the designation of the obsolete account from which grants-in-
4 aid are awarded; amending the amount of grants that can be awarded under the grant-in-
5 aid program; and generally relating to the grant-in-aid program.

7 BY repealing and reenacting with amendments: § 4-11-107(b)
8 Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended)

10 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*
11 That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as follows:

13 **ARTICLE 4 FINANCE, TAXATION, AND BUDGET**
14 **TITLE 11. BUDGET**

16 **§ 4-11-107. Grant-in-aid program.**

18 (b) **Contribution.** On fulfilling the conditions in subsection (a), the association shall be
19 eligible for a contribution by the County [from the community promotions account of the
20 County Executive's budget. The contribution shall be equal to 10% of the cost of the building
21 or \$10,000, whichever is less]. THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE MAY AWARD A GRANT-IN-AID IN
22 AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$10,000 OR, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL, IN
23 AN AMOUNT IN EXCESS OF \$10,000.

[Brackets] indicate matter stricken from existing law.

1 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days
2 from the date it becomes law.
