9 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County,*
10 *Maryland,* That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as

1 (c) **Districts.** The school impact fee districts shall be as shown on the school impact
2 fee districts map, and the transportation impact fee districts shall be as shown on the
3 transportation impact fee districts map, both as adopted by the County Council. The
4 school impact fee district map and the transportation impact fee district map, both
5 prepared by the Office of Planning and Zoning and dated May 1, 1992, and [July 20,
6 1987] MAY 8, 2009, respectively, are adopted as the development impact fee district maps.
7 The public safety impact fee district shall be the County as a whole.

8
9 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days
10 from the date it becomes law.
