A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE concerning: Current Expense Budget – Anne Arundel
2 Community College –Transfer of Funds

4 FOR the purpose of transferring appropriations of funds between major categories of the
5 Higher Education Fund; and making this Ordinance an emergency measure.

7 BY amending: Current Expense Budget

8
9 WHEREAS, under Section 711(a) of the Charter, upon recommendation of the
10 County Executive, the County Council may transfer funds between offices,
11 departments, institutions, boards, commissions or other agencies of the County
12 government and within the same fund of the Current Expense Budget; and

14 WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended additional appropriations
15 and the Controller has certified in writing that such funds are available for
16 appropriation; now, therefore,

18 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County,*
19 *Maryland,* That the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009 is
20 hereby amended by transferring funds from the below listed accounts in the Higher
21 Education Fund in the respective amounts set forth:

23 Plant Operations \$ 160,000
24 Student Services \$ 200,000
25 Institutional Support \$ 65,000

SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, welfare, and property and being passed by the affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, the same shall take effect from the date it becomes law.
