4 FOR the purpose of adopting a new transportation impact fee district map.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments: § 17-11-109(c)  
7 Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended)

9 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County,*  
10 *Maryland,* That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as  
11 follows:

13 **ARTICLE 17 SUBDIVISION AND DEVELOPMENT**

15 **TITLE 11. FEES AND SECURITY**

17 **17-11-209. Use of funds.**

19 (c) **Districts.** The school impact fee districts shall be as shown on the school impact  
20 fee districts map, and the transportation impact fee districts shall be as shown on the  
21 transportation impact fee districts [map, both] MAPS, as adopted by the County Council.  
22 The school impact fee district map PREPARED BY THE OFFICE OF PLANNING AND ZONING  
23 AND DATED MAY 1, 1992, and the transportation impact fee district [map, both] MAPS  
24 prepared by the Office of Planning and Zoning and dated [May 1, 1992, and] July 20,

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS indicate new matter added to existing law.

1 1987, AND MAY 8, 2009, [respectively,] are adopted as the development impact fee district  
2 maps. The public safety impact fee district shall be the County as a whole.

4 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days  
5 from the date it becomes law.
