1 RESOLUTION approving the appointment of Linton Pumphrey as a supervisor of the
2 Anne Arundel Soil Conservation District

4 WHEREAS, § 8-302 of the Agriculture Article of the Annotated Code of
5 Maryland provides that the governing body of each soil conservation district
6 consists of five supervisors; and

8 WHEREAS, § 8-302 provides that one of the supervisors shall be a resident of the
9 district appointed by the governing body; and

11 WHEREAS, the County Executive, subject to approval by the County Council,
12 has appointed Linton Pumphrey, a resident of the Anne Arundel Soil
13 Conservation District, as a supervisor of the soil conservation district for a term
14 that commences on February 1, 2009, and expires on January 31, 2014; and

16 WHEREAS, the County Council, after public hearing, finds that Linton
17 Pumphrey meets the eligibility requirements under § 8-302, and is qualified to
18 serve as a supervisor of the Anne Arundel Soil Conservation District; now,
19 therefore, be it

21 *Resolved by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,* That it hereby
22 approves the appointment of Linton Pumphrey, a resident of the district, as a supervisor
23 of the Anne Arundel Soil Conservation District for a term that expires on January 31,
24 2014; and be it further

26 *Resolved,* That a copy of this Resolution be sent to County Executive John R.
27 Leopold; Kenneth Carr, Chair of the Anne Arundel Soil Conservation District; Linton
28 Pumphrey; and Arlene Berlin, Director of Boards and Commissions.
