1 RESOLUTION approving the application to the City of Annapolis for a Violence  
2 Prevention Initiative (“VPI”) grant under the Collaborative Supervision and Focused  
3 Enforcement Initiative (“CSAFE”) and recognizing the County Executive’s authority to  
4 act in connection with the grant

6 WHEREAS, the County has prepared an application for a VPI grant under  
7 CSAFE, seeking a grant in the amount of \$35,000 (the “Application”); and

8  
9 WHEREAS, under the Application, the County is required to provide \$0 in  
10 matching funds; and

11  
12 WHEREAS, the Office of State's Attorney is the agency that will administer the  
13 expenditure of the grant and any matching funds; and

15 WHEREAS, the County Executive has requested that the County Council approve  
16 the Application; and

18 WHEREAS, Section 306 of the Anne Arundel County Charter provides that the  
19 County Council shall have the power to accept gifts and grants; now, therefore be  
20 it

22 *Resolved by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,* That it approves  
23 the application to the City of Annapolis for a VPI grant under CSAFE in the amount of  
24 \$35,000 with \$0 matching funds, which grant is to be administered by Office of State's  
25 Attorney; and be it further

27 *Resolved,* That the County Council recognizes that the County Executive or the  
28 County Executive’s designee is duly authorized to act in connection with the grant; and  
29 be it further

31 *Resolved,* That a copy of this Resolution be sent to County Executive John R.
