A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE concerning: Capital Budget and Program – Columbia
2 SECD – Additional Appropriation

3
4 FOR the purpose of amending the Capital Budget by making an additional appropriation
5 of funds to the Columbia SECD capital project; amending the Capital Program and
6 Capital Projects Bond Ordinance; and making this Ordinance an emergency measure.

8 BY amending: Capital Budget
9 Capital Program

12 WHEREAS, the capital project, Columbia SECD, Project No. Q540500, has an
13 existing appropriation, and additional funding of \$886,700 in loan funds and
14 technical and administrative services has become available from the Maryland
15 Department of Natural Resources, which was not anticipated in budget estimates
16 for fiscal year 2010; and

18 WHEREAS, Sections 712 and 716 of the Charter authorize the County Council,
19 upon request of the County Executive and by affirmative vote of five members of
20 the County Council, to amend the capital budget to increase the total amount of
21 appropriations to the capital budgets from revenues from sources anticipated in
22 the budget but in excess of budget estimates for the current fiscal year; and

1 WHEREAS, the County Executive is requesting that \$886,700 in loan funds and
2 technical and administrative services from the Maryland Department of Natural
3 Resources be appropriated to the capital project, Columbia SECD, Project No.
4 Q540500; and

6 WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 716 of the Charter, the County Executive
7 and the Planning Advisory Board have recommended amendments to the Capital
8 Budget; and
9

10 WHEREAS, the Controller has certified in writing that such funds are available
11 for appropriation; now, therefore,
12

13 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County,*
14 *Maryland,* that the Capital Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, is hereby
15 amended by making an additional appropriation of ~~\$866,700~~ \$886,700 in loan funds and
16 technical and administrative services from the Maryland Department of Natural
17 Resources, which was not anticipated in the budget estimates for fiscal year 2010, to the
18 Columbia SECD, Project No. Q540500.

20 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That the Capital Program and Capital Projects
21 Bond Ordinance for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, are hereby amended in
22 accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance.
23

24 SECTION 3. *And be it further enacted,* That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be
25 an emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
26 peace, health, safety, welfare, and property, and being passed by the affirmative vote of
27 five members of the County Council, the same shall take effect from the date it becomes
28 law.
