13 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County,*
14 *Maryland, That § 2-2-102(c) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) be*
15 *and is hereby repealed.*

17 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted by That § 2-2-102(d) and (e) of the Anne*
18 *Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) is hereby renumbered to be § 2-2-102(c) and*
19 *(d).*

(1) Annually, prior to January 1, each member of the County Council shall elect to have the use of a County owned and maintained automobile or to be compensated for transportation expenses by payment from the budget of a monthly allowance in the amount of \$350 per month. Any member of the County Council who fails to make a timely election is entitled to be compensated for transportation expenses for that year.

(2) A member of the County Council may only use a County owned automobile within the State and, if on official County business, outside the State.]
