A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE concerning: Combustion ash

2
3 FOR the purpose of extending the termination date established by Bill No. 64-07, as
4 amended by Bill No. 62-08 and Bill No. 71-09, of certain provisions relating to
5 combustion ash; and making this Ordinance an emergency measure.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments: Bill No. 64-07, Section 3, Laws of Anne
8 Arundel County 2007, as amended by Bill No. 62-08, Section 1, Laws of Anne
9 Arundel County 2008, and as amended by Bill No. 71-09, Section 1, Laws of Anne
10 Arundel County 2009

12 WHEREAS, Bill No. 64-07 makes certain amendments to the Anne Arundel
13 County Code (2005, as amended) relating to combustion ash and provides that
14 those amendments shall end one year from the effective date of Bill No. 64-07;
15 and

17 WHEREAS, Bill No. 62-08 amended Bill No. 64-07, so that the provisions of Bill
18 No. 64-07 shall terminate two years from the effective date of Bill No. 64-07; and

20 WHEREAS, Bill No. 71-09 amended Bill No. 64-07, so that the provisions of Bill
21 No. 64-07 shall terminate three years from the effective date of Bill No. 64-07;
22 and

24 WHEREAS, Bill No. 64-07 became effective October 2, 2007; and

26 WHEREAS, the amendments to the County Code made by Bill No. 64-07 have
27 been beneficial and continue to be beneficial for Anne Arundel County,

1 Maryland; and

3 WHEREAS, the County Executive has requested that the County Council
4 continue these amendments regarding combustion ash; now, therefore

5

6 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County,*
7 *Maryland,* That the Laws of Anne Arundel County, 2007, Bill No. 64-07, Section 3, as
8 amended by the Laws of Anne Arundel County 2008, Bill No. 62-08, Section 1, and as
9 amended by the Laws of Anne Arundel County 2009, Bill No. 71-09, Section 1, be and
10 they are hereby amended to read as follows:

14 SECTION 3. *And be it further enacted,* That the provisions of this
15 Ordinance shall remain in effect for [three] FOUR years from the effective
16 date of this Ordinance, after which it shall stand repealed and with no
17 further action required by the County Council, be of no further force and
18 effect.

20 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be
21 an emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
22 peace, health, safety, welfare, and property and being passed by the affirmative vote of
23 five members of the County Council, the same shall take effect from the date it becomes
24 law.
