1 RESOLUTION approving the application to the Governor’s Office of Crime Control and
2 Prevention for a grant under the Law Enforcement Training Scholarship Program (“LETS”)
3 and recognizing the County Executive’s authority to act in connection with the grant

5 WHEREAS, the County has prepared an application for a grant under the Law
6 Enforcement Training Scholarship Program (“LETS”), seeking a grant in the amount
7 of \$7,600 (the “Application”); and
8

9 WHEREAS, under the Application, the County is required to provide \$0 in matching
10 funds; and

12 WHEREAS, the Police Department is the County Agency that will administer the
13 expenditure of the grant and any matching funds; and

15 WHEREAS, the County Executive has requested that the County Council approve
16 the Application; and

18 WHEREAS, Section 306 of the Anne Arundel County Charter provides that the
19 County Council shall have the power to accept gifts and grants; now, therefore, be it

21 *Resolved by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,* That it approves
22 the application to the Governor’s Office of Crime Control and Prevention for a grant under
23 the Law Enforcement Training Scholarship Program (“LETS”) in the amount of \$7,600 with
24 \$0 matching funds, which grant is to be administered by the Police Department; and be it

27 *Resolved,* That the County Council recognizes that the County Executive or the County
28 Executive’s designee is duly authorized to act in connection with the grant; and be it further
