1       RESOLUTION approving the application to the Governor’s Office of Crime Control &  
2 Prevention for a grant under the Byrne Justice Recovery Act Grant Program and recognizing  
3 the County Executive’s authority to act in connection with the grant  
4

5       WHEREAS, the County Health Department has prepared an application for a grant  
6 under the Governor’s Office of Crime Control & Prevention’s Byrne Justice  
7 Recovery Act Grant Program, seeking a grant in the amount of \$16,800 for the  
8 Health Department’s Strengthening Families program (the “Application”); and

10       WHEREAS, under the Application, the County is required to provide \$0 in matching  
11 funds; and  
12

13       WHEREAS, the Health Department is the agency that will administer the  
14 expenditure of the grant and any matching funds; and  
15

16       WHEREAS, the County Executive has requested that the County Council approve  
17 the Application; and  
18

19       WHEREAS, Section 306 of the Anne Arundel County Charter provides that the  
20 County Council shall have the power to accept gifts and grants; now, therefore be it

22       *Resolved by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,* That it approves  
23 the application to the Governor’s Office of Crime Control & Prevention for a grant under the  
24 Byrne Justice Recovery Act Grant Program in the amount of \$16,800 with \$0 matching  
25 funds for the Health Department’s Strengthening Families program, which grant is to be  
26 administered by Health Department; and be it further

28       *Resolved,* That the County Council recognizes that the County Executive or the County  
29 Executive’s designee is duly authorized to act in connection with the grant; and be it further

31       *Resolved,* That a copy of this Resolution be sent to County Executive John R. Leopold.
