1 RESOLUTION approving the application to the Maryland Department of Natural  
2 Resources for a grant for construction of facilities at the Jug Bay Wetlands Sanctuary and  
3 recognizing the County Executive's authority to act in connection with the grant

5 WHEREAS, the County has prepared an application to the Maryland Department of  
6 Natural Resources for a grant for construction of facilities at the Jug Bay Wetlands  
7 Sanctuary, seeking a grant in the amount of \$13,264 (the "Application"); and  
8

9 WHEREAS, under the Application, the County is required to provide \$6,680 in  
10 matching funds; and  
11

12 WHEREAS, the Department of Recreation and Parks is the County Agency that will  
13 administer the expenditure of the grant and any matching funds; and  
14

15 WHEREAS, the County Executive has requested that the County Council approve  
16 the Application; and

18 WHEREAS, Section 306 of the Anne Arundel County Charter provides that the  
19 County Council shall have the power to accept gifts and grants; now, therefore, be it

21 *Resolved by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,* That it approves  
22 the application to the Maryland Department of Natural Resources for a grant for construction  
23 of facilities at the Jug Bay Wetlands Sanctuary in the amount of \$ 13,264 with \$6,680 in  
24 matching funds, which grant is to be administered by the Department of Recreation and  
25 Parks; and be it further

27 *Resolved,* That the County Council recognizes that the County Executive or the County  
28 Executive's designee is duly authorized to act in connection with the grant; and be it further

30 *Resolved,* That a copy of this Resolution be sent to County Executive John R. Leopold.
