1 RESOLUTION approving the application to the Maryland State Police for a grant as a
2 member of the Maryland Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force and recognizing the
3 County Executive's authority to act in connection with the grant

5 WHEREAS, by virtue of becoming a member of the Maryland Internet Crimes
6 Against Children Task Force, the County has applied for a grant of funds to assist in
7 the investigation of computer facilitated crimes against children in the amount of
8 \$25,000 (the "Application"); and

10 WHEREAS, under the Application, the County is required to provide \$0 in matching
11 funds; and

13 WHEREAS, the Police Department is the County Agency that will administer the
14 expenditure of the grant and any matching funds; and

16 WHEREAS, the County Executive has requested that the County Council approve
17 the Application; and

19 WHEREAS, Section 306 of the Anne Arundel County Charter provides that the
20 County Council shall have the power to accept gifts and grants; now, therefore, be it

22 *Resolved by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,* That it approves
23 the application to the Maryland State Police for a grant as a member of the Maryland Internet
24 Crimes Against Children Task Force in the amount of \$25,000 with \$0 matching funds,
25 which grant is to be administered by the Police Department; and be it further

27 *Resolved,* That the County Council recognizes that the County Executive or the County
28 Executive's designee is duly authorized to act in connection with the grant; and be it further
