A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE concerning: – Current Expense Budget – Anne
2 Arundel Community College – Additional Appropriation

3
4 FOR the purpose of making additional appropriations from unanticipated revenues to the
5 Higher Education Fund; and making this Ordinance an emergency measure.

7 BY amending: Current Expense Budget

8
9 WHEREAS, under Section 712 of the Charter, upon the recommendation of the
10 County Executive, the County Council may make additional appropriations from
11 revenues received from anticipated sources but in excess of budget estimates,
12 provided that the Controller shall first certify in writing that such funds are
13 available for appropriation; and

15 WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended additional appropriations
16 and the Controller has certified in writing that such funds are available for
17 appropriation; now, therefore,

19 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County,*
20 *Maryland,* That the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, be
21 and it is hereby amended by making additional appropriations from available special
22 revenues in the Higher Education Fund in the total amount of \$7,757,800 to the State
23 funding category Auxiliary, Enterprise & Restricted Sources in the Higher Education
24 Fund in the amount of \$7,757,800

26 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be
27 an emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public

1 peace, health, safety, welfare, and property and being passed by the affirmative vote of
2 five members of the County Council, the same shall take effect from the date it becomes
3 law.
