9 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County,*
10 *Maryland,* That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as

15 TITLE 3. JUDICIAL BRANCH

17 **2-3-108. Recordation tax.**

19 (C) **Collection.** THE TAX ON INSTRUMENTS RECORDED WITH THE CLERK OF THE
20 CIRCUIT COURT SHALL BE COLLECTED BY THE CONTROLLER PRIOR TO RECORDATION.

22 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Ordinance shall apply to all
23 instruments submitted for recordation on and after January 1, 2008.

1 SECTION 3. *And be it further enacted*, That this Ordinance shall take effect on July
2 1, 2007.
