### **AACo. Conflict Resolution Center (NC)**

**\$20,000**

Purpose: 1. To provide free and accessible conflict resolution services in order to promote constructive management and resolution of conflict/dispute throughout AACo. 2. To expand existing services to target the Hispanic/Latino community.

### **AACo. Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) (NC)**

**\$30,000**

Purpose: 1. To fund staff salaries. 2. To provide a valuable, high quality advocacy service to abused/neglected children, to increase their safety and improve their outcome for a permanent placement.

### **AACO. Economic Opportunity Committee (NC)**

**\$200,000**

Purpose: 1. To support services and opportunities that eliminate the causes and conditions of poverty. 2. To fund staff salaries. 3. To fund operating expenses.

### **AACo. Food Bank (NC)**

**\$75,000**

Purpose: 1. To help fight hunger by assisting all Anne Arundel County residents in need to have access to food and other resources to make their lives better for themselves and everyone around them. 2. To support salaries. 3. To fund occupancy costs.

### **AACo. Mental Health Agency (NC)**

**\$210,000**

Purpose: 1. To provide mobile crisis response services and assertive community treatment to AA citizens who are seeking or have a need to immediate mental health services. 2. To support a crisis mobile team, as well as crisis outreach services.

### **AA Workforce Development Corporation (AAWDC) (NC)**

**\$125,000**

Purpose: 1. To support staffing and maintain one-stop career centers at BWI Airport, Annapolis, Arundel Mills, Fort Meade, Freetown, Glen Burnie, and the Ordnance Road Detention Center. 2. To expand business and job seeker services and increase summer job programs for youth. 3. To administer the Senior Community Service Program and Employment Program, which assist low-income senior citizens.

### **American Red Cross (NC)**

**\$10,000**

Purpose: To provide disaster relief to all victims of local disaster and disaster preparedness education for all interested Anne Arundel County residents.

### **Annapolis Area Ministries (C)**

**\$350,000**

Purpose: 1. To build a new 22,000 square foot center in Parole. 2. To expand programs and services for homeless people and those in crisis, including financial literacy classes, job training, legal counseling, and employment referrals.

**Arts Council of AACo. (NC)**

**\$260,000**

Purpose: 1. To provide funding for music, dance, drama, and the visual arts to non-profit cultural arts organizations that present programs and exhibits in this county. 2. To fund operating expenses.

**Arundel Child Care Connections (NC)**

**\$55,000**

Purpose: To support operating programs and services offered, such as free child care referral, training for all licensed child care providers, technical assistance for those interested in becoming a family child care provider or opening a center, and early childhood mental health services.

**Arundel Habitat for Humanity (C)**

**\$10,000**

Purpose: 1. To assist in the funding of a partnership among Arundel Habitat for Humanity, Annapolis Public Housing Authority, and Penrose Development LLC to renovate public housing at Obery Court. 2. Underwrite the cost of infrastructure to build 14 new houses to be completed by December 2009. 3. Grant 14 families who currently live in public housing the opportunity of becoming habitat homeowners.

**Arundel House of Hope (NC)**

**\$15,000**

Purpose: 1. To fund daily organization's operation to provide the homeless in AACo. with support and related services. 2. To fund the Homeless Day and Resource Center.

**Centro Cristiano Betania (NC)**

**\$14,000**

Purpose: 1. To assist eligible Hispanic/Latino individuals residing in AACo. become U.S. citizens. 2. To fund general operating expenses.

**Chesapeake Arts Center (NC)**

**\$40,000**

Purpose: 1. To expand the cultural arts programs and offer them at affordable costs to citizens of northern Anne Arundel County. 2. To fund general operating expenses.

**Children's Theatre of Annapolis (C)**

**\$20,000**

Purpose: 1. To support the cost of equipment needed to complete the construction of the full service professional 256 seat theater complex built at Bay Head Park. 2. To provide a safe, nurturing and challenging experience for youth.

**Community Talent Associates (NC)**

**\$1,500**

Purpose: To offer age appropriate programs held in Community Centers of the Annapolis Housing Authority's properties.

**Food Link (NC)**

**\$5,000**

Purpose: 1. To deliver food that is edible but not sellable at no cost to the needy residents in AACo. 2. To partially support the operating expenses for the wholesale produce program.

**Freetown Community Improvement Association (C)**

**\$150,000**

Purpose: To assist in funding inspection of and improvements to the Association's building.

**Galesville Rosenwald School (C)** **\$200,000**  
Purpose: To restore and made capital improvements to the Historic Rosenwald School located in Galesville, MD., to be used as a community center to provide physical space for community needs, including access to services such as recreation, senior activities, and youth services.

**HIV/AIDS Volunteer Enrichment (HAVEN) (NC)** **\$5,000**  
Purpose: 1. To continue to enhance the quality of life for those affected by HIV in Anne Arundel County. 2. To fund operating expenses.

**HOPE (NC)** **\$3,500**  
Purpose: 1. To assist AACo. residents without sufficient resources to provide for their own basic needs. 2. To assist for supplies and materials.

**Hospice of the Chesapeake (NC)** **\$15,000**  
Purpose: 1. To provide critical support to bereaved children and adults. 2. To assist families with the grief experience and subsequent life changes that ensue after the death of a loved one.

**Kunta-Kinte-Alex Haley Foundation (NC)** **\$5,000**  
Purpose: To provide funds that will support the Foundation in its mission to spread Alex Haley's vision that celebrates ethnic diversity through education and cultural programs.

**Leadership Anne Arundel (NC)** **\$4,000**  
Purpose: 1. To develop and implement the community service component of Leadership Anne Arundel's Neighborhood Leadership Academy class of 2008. 2. To offer participants three days of training in practical community service. 3. To create an understanding of the coordination and development issues involved in neighborhood self-help while performing volunteer service to increase capital in AACo.

**Legal Aid Bureau (NC)** **\$35,000**  
Purpose: 1. To provide full legal representation to persons in contested custody cases, especially where the children are at risk from abuse or neglect. 2. To fund operating expenses.

**Mark 10:14, Inc. (NC)** **\$10,000**  
Purpose: To fund the Clay Street Children's Collaborative program and provide youth with the opportunity to explore the arts.

**Martin Luther King Award Breakfast (NC)** **\$5,000**  
Purpose: To fund expenses related to the Award ceremony.

**Maryland Hall for the Creative Arts (C)** **\$100,000**  
Purpose: To fund architectural and acoustical studies for a small theatre and a performance space, and rehabilitation of outmoded restrooms and classrooms.

**Opportunity Builders (C)****\$65,000**

Purpose: To assist in completing the construction of a new 41,000 square foot vocational training facility in Millersville, MD. to be used to provide daily services to individuals with disabilities and their families.

**Partners in Care (NC)****\$45,000**

Purpose: To fund a member-care coordinator of service's position and a transportation coordinator's position to help older and disabled adults remain independent in their own homes.

**Restoration Community Development Corp. (NC)****\$15,000**

Purpose: To provide programs to county's low to moderate-income children, youth and families to lead a path toward breaking the cycle of poverty.

**Robert A. Pascal Youth & Family Services (NC)****\$25,000**

Purpose: 1. To assist in providing comprehensive and accessible individual, family and group counseling and educational services to Anne Arundel County residents. 2. To fund salaries for therapists.

**Rob's Barbershop Community Foundation (NC)****\$2,000**

Purpose: 1. To assist in the cost for the installation and maintenance of a full service two-station barber/styling salon located within the newly constructed Annapolis based Lighthouse Shelter. 2. To provide affordable grooming products and services for individuals living at the shelter at (or below) current U.S. poverty guidelines.

**Sarah's House (NC)****\$20,000**

Purpose: To provide safe shelter, daily meals, and personal, as well as professional casework support for those in need at Sarah's House, serving homeless children and their families referred by the Anne Arundel County Department of Social Services.

**The AACo. Commission for Women (NC)****\$3,000**

Purpose: 1. To fund and support the Commission's expenses associated with an annual planning retreat, a variety of forums, and a project of the Student Associate. 2. To fund general operating expenses associated to address county issues that had an adverse effect on women, including, but not limited, to workplace discrimination, barriers to educational opportunity, etc.

**The ARC of the Central Chesapeake Region (NC)****\$95,000**

Purpose: 1. To fund its Community Outreach Program to provide low income and BRAC families with effective and equitable access to services and supports for children and adults who have developmental disabilities. 2. To fund operating costs and case management services. 3. To fund a Health Care Training Program.

**The Metropolitan Washington EAR (NC)****\$1,500**

Purpose: 1. To provide comprehensive and extensive services for the blind/visually impaired community. 2. To cover the costs of providing Dial-In and Radio Reading Services.

**Volunteer Center for Anne Arundel (NC)**

**\$30,000**

Purpose: 1. To improve the quality of life in AACo. through effective volunteering. 2. To recruit and train volunteers to solve serious community problems.

**Wiley H. Bates Legacy Center (NC)**

**\$10,000**

Purpose: 1. To host an exhibit highlighting the accomplishments of Bates alumni and faculty and other notable African American community leaders. 2. To fund operating expenses.

**YWCA of Annapolis & AACo. (NC)**

**\$75,000**

Purpose: To support the Safe House and shelter services offered to female domestic violence victims and their children by the Arden House.
