

MD RT 214 AT MD RT. 468 IMPROVEMENTS

Background

The intersection of MD Rt. 214 and MD Rt. 468 is a major crossroad through which a large volume of traffic passes to access the southeast part of the county, more specifically the Mayo peninsula and points south such as Galesville and Shady Side. Likewise, a large volume of vehicles access this part of the county during morning and evening rush hours. This project is intended to improve the intersection to provide a satisfactory level of service, improve bicycle and pedestrian access, while limiting property and environmental impacts.

Benefits

- Improve the level of service and safety of a currently “failed” intersection
- Improve bicycle access and safety
- Improve traffic signaling
- Planned improvements:
 - A continuous additional WB lane on MD Rt. 214
 - A right turn lane to be added for EB MD Rt. 214 onto MD Rt. 468 SB
 - Two left turn lanes for NB MD Rt. 468 onto WB MD Rt. 214
 - One right turn lane from NB MD Rt. 468 onto EB MD Rt. 214
 - One left turn lane from WB MD Rt. 214 onto SB MD Rt. 468
- This project is part of the Edgewater/Mayo Small Area Plan



Project Status

The project is proposed to be constructed in two phases. The second continuous through lane along eastbound MD Rt. 214 west of the intersection and the extension of the second continuous eastbound through lane east of the intersection are the Phase 2 improvements. This phasing is being implemented to provide immediate relief to the congested intersection, and due to the more extensive permitting required for Phase 2 of the project. The project design is complete. The County is in process of acquiring the remaining permit necessary to bid and construct the project. The County conducted presentations to address questions and concerns on 12/1/03 and 1/28/04.
