

SEVERN FIRE STATION

A NEW FIRE STATION TO PROVIDE FIRST RESPONSE TO THE COMMUNITY

Background

The fire location study performed by the Fire Department in 1991 and then in 2000 recommended that a fire station is required in the Severn area to meet the demands of the surrounding communities. Currently, the Severn area is served by four (4) different stations located at Harmans /Dorsey, Odenton, Jessup, and South Glen Burnie. This new Severn Fire Station will have three (3) drive thru bays to house fire and medical apparatus.



Benefits

- Increased response time to address the needs of the communities
- Provide first response to the property owners
- Station will have medical and fire apparatus on site
- Other stations can be used for additional apparatus in case of severe fire/medical emergency
- New station will provide separate facilities for men and women
