

# WEST COUNTY LIBRARY

## Background

West County Regional Library is a two-story, 38,000 square foot library located on 23.9 acres at the intersection of Rt. 170 and Rt. 175. The first floor will house the children's collection, circulation desk, meeting rooms and staff work area. The second floor will have the adult collection, study rooms, and computer lab. The site has 190 parking spaces for the public and staff. The building uses new innovative storm water management techniques. This includes a "green" living roof of plants which absorb nutrients and reduce runoff on part of the roof. The library collection includes 142,800 volume of books; 7,000 DVD's; 4,000 CD's; 332 periodicals; 4,700 video cassettes; and 6,000 book on tapes. The library will also house 56 computers for public use.
