

WOODLAND BEACH FORCE MAIN

Background

The overall project consists of the upgrade and expansion of the Woodland Beach Sewage Pumping Station. This contract involves the construction of a 24-inch force main along the east side of MD Rt. 2, starting at Virginia Avenue and extending north along MD Rt. 2 to Home Port Farm north along MD Rt. 2, east along MD Rt. 665 to Forest Drive and connect with an existing 30 inch force main, at the Bay Ridge Shopping Center, which discharges at the Annapolis Water Reclamation Facility.

Benefits

The completed project will allow continued reliable wastewater service to the existing users of the County sewer system as well as allow expansion of the system as needed in the Edgewater / Woodland Beach / Londontown service area.
