

WOODLAND BEACH SEWAGE PUMP STATION AND FORCE MAIN UPGRADE

Background

To accommodate sewerage needs of the Edgewater / Woodland Beach / Londontown Sewer Service Area, a project is underway to expand the capacity of the Woodland Beach Sewage Pumping Station. The project consists of the construction of an expanded pumping station and the installation of a new 24" diameter force main from the pumping station site on Mayo Road to the existing sewage conveyance system located at the intersection of Hillsmere Drive and Forest Drive. The new force main alignment will follow Maryland Routes 2 and 665 and a portion of Forest Drive. The overall project consists of five individual construction contracts. One contract will consist of the expansion of the sewage pumping station, while the remaining four contracts provide for the installation of the sewage force main. The new conveyance system parallels the existing utility infrastructure which has been in service since the mid 1980's. Treatment of the wastewater will continue to occur at the Annapolis Water Reclamation Facility. As part of the Department's continued outreach efforts, plans for the project were shared with representatives of the communities on the Edgewater/Mayo Citizens' Advisory Committee.

Benefits

The completed project will allow continued reliable wastewater service to the existing users of the County sewer system as well as allow expansion of the system as needed in the Edgewater / Woodland Beach / Londontown service area.
