

LAKE WATERFORD CHALLENGER FIELD

Background

The construction consists of a “Challenger” baseball field at Lake Waterford Park, approximately 25,808 sf, with a wheelchair accessible rubberized playing surface over asphalt to replace the existing field, covered wheelchair accessible dugout, fencing around entire field perimeter with backstop, field striping and multipurpose field overlay, path connections from field to parking lot, concrete pads for future shed and portable toilet area, existing parking lot re-striping for additional handicap spaces, storm water management, and other related site improvements.

Benefits

- Provides wheelchair accessible playing field for children with disabilities
- Allows children with disabilities to compete with each other within the Metro Region
- This field will be the first of its kind to be constructed in Anne Arundel County and the Department of Recreation & Parks anticipates that it may be the first in the State of Maryland
