

MD 173 TO MD 177 CONNECTION

Background

The section of MD Rt. 607, from the intersection of MD Rt. 100 to south of MD Rt. 177, experiences heavy traffic congestion, particularly at evening rush hour. Improvements will be made at the intersection of MD Rt. 100 and MD Rt. 607 and along a significant portion of MD Rt. 607 north of the intersection to MD Rt. 177. There are intersection improvements to be made by a developer to MD Rt. 607 at the intersection with MD Rt. 177. The scope of these projects is being coordinated for design consistency.

Benefits

- A second dedicated left turn lane will be added from eastbound MD Rt. 100 onto northbound MD Rt. 607
- A receiving lane will be added for northbound MD Rt. 607 for a length of 1100 feet
- Improvements will be made to the storm water drainage system associated with the roadway improvements

Project Status

The Contractor will re- **Updated February 9, 2011**
mobilize and continue work on or about February 16, 2011. There will be daytime lane closures on the ramps and nighttime lane closures on MD 607 beginning in mid-March. Additional daytime lane closures may be scheduled.
