

Parish Creek Dredging

Background

Parish Creek, a tributary of the West River, is a popular waterway in Anne Arundel County. Parish Creek is surrounded by numerous residences, marinas, and commercial waterfronts with water access. Local residents have requested that Anne Arundel County restore boating access to the creek that is now substantially impaired.

The project includes two phases:

(1) Federal channel dredging and (2) County channel dredging. The US Corps of Engineers dredged the Federal Channel providing deep water access to the Bay in winter/spring 2010. The County Channel connects upriver to the Federal Channel and will occur during fall 2010/winter 2011.
