You asked whether a currently employed guard at the county detention center could be appointed to the position of inspector for the liquor board. I find nothing in the Public Ethics Law that would prohibit this employment. However, the employee cannot work for the liquor board during his official work day, cannot drive a county vehicle or appear in his county uniform while on liquor board business.

I am sorry that I cannot answer your questions with regard to pension matters; that would be issues for the Office of Personnel or Office of Law. Thank you for your inquiry. If you have other questions, call any time.
