You inquired whether police officers who regularly teach police procedures at the police training academy may accept secondary employment from the community college to teach the proper use of handcuffs and pepper spray to campus security officers. The ethics commission believes that because of the specialized knowledge required to teach these procedures, it is within the discretion of the police department to permit this secondary employment.
