Firefighters from the Anne Arundel County Fire Department visited your child's first grade class today and delivered a presentation called "**Community Helpers**".

During the presentation first graders were encouraged to be community helpers like fire fighters, police officers and teachers by sharing fire safety information with others.

Take a few minutes to review the following safety tips that were reviewed today with the students.

STOP, DROP AND ROLL

If your clothes catch on fire never run. Cover your face with your hands while you are rolling on the floor to extinguish the fire.

SMOKE ALARMS SAVE LIVES

Smoke alarms should be checked monthly and have the batteries replaced at least once a year.

HOME FIRE ESCAPE PLANS

Practice fire drills at home just like students do at school. Good fire escape plans include working smoke alarms, two ways out of every room we sleep in, and a safe meeting place.

SAFE MEETING PLACE

Every household needs to have a designated safe meeting place near the front of the home to meet in an emergency. Good safe meeting places are things like the mailbox, a tree in the front yard or where the car parks.
