At the October 13, 2009 hearing, before the Board of License Commissioners (“Board”) appeared the Licensee, David A. Masson, Vice President/Secretary of Sun Pok’s Willy D’s, Inc., trading as Willy D’s Lounge, 9001 Fort Smallwood Road, Pasadena, Maryland (“Premises”). The following 4 Counts were as follows:

Count 1: Violation of the Rules and Regulations of the Board of License Commissioners for Anne Arundel County, Chapter 3, Section 3.01 (c) “Ownership and Operation”; RE: Letters from Deputy Administrator Edward I. Aronson dated November 10, 2008; June 5, 2009 and Anne Arundel County Police Report #2009-723497 by Cpl. Guy, #1515 and Officer Valentin, #1648 dated June 18, 2009.

Count 2: Violation of the Rules and Regulations of the Board of License Commissioners for Anne Arundel County, Chapter 3, Section 3.02 (a) & (b) “Cooperation”; RE: Letters from Deputy Administrator Edward I. Aronson dated November 10, 2008; June 5, 2009 and Anne Arundel County Police Report #2009-723497 by Cpl. Guy, #1515 and Officer Valentin, #1648 dated June 18, 2009.

In light of admission and testimony presented, the Board makes the following findings.

1. The Board merged Count 4 into Count 3 and found the Licensee guilty of Count 3. Count 1 and Count 2 are interrelated and were dismissed by the Board. As to Count 3 the Board imposes a reprimand.
2. In addition the Board imposes hearing costs of three hundred dollars (\$300.00). This amount must be paid to the Board, 94 Franklin Street, Annapolis, Maryland not later than Wednesday, October 21, 2009.
3. Furthermore, the Licensees must file a management agreement within ten (10) days of this Order.
