Count 4: Violation of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland, Section 12-108 (a) “Sales to minors and intoxicated persons prohibited”; RE: Anne Arundel County Police Report #2009-724240 by Cpl. Guy, #1515 and Officer Valentin, #1648 dated June 23, 2009.

In light of the admission and testimony presented, the Board makes the following findings.

1. The Board finds the Licensees guilty of Count 1. As to Count 1 the Board imposes a fine of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00).
2. In addition the Board imposes hearing costs of five hundred dollars (\$500.00). The total amount assessed totals to be seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$750.00). This amount must be paid to the Board, 94 Franklin Street, Annapolis, Maryland not later than Monday, December 21, 2009.
3. Furthermore, the Board merges Count 2 into Count 1 as a matter of law.
