## NEW CAPITAL FACILITY RECOUPMENT CHARGE EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 1, 2011

Effective October 1, 2011, Anne Arundel County residential Utility Customers will pay an additional \$2.04 per thousand gallon for water usage exceeding 30,000 gallons in any given quarterly billing period. The Capital Facility Recoupment charge is part of County Council-approved Bill 37-11 and targets residents that use more capacity than the capital facility connection charge rate limit of 250 gallon per day.

**DPW will credit customers charged this fee during the last billing cycle.**

- WHO:** Anne Arundel County Residential Utility Customers
- WHAT:** Capital Facility Recoupment Charge for residential customers exceeding 30,000 gallons of water usage in any given quarterly billing period.
- WHEN:** Effective October 1, 2011
- WHY:** To recoup lost revenue from customers exceeding the maximum capacity limits within the residential capital facility connection charge.

### EXAMPLE: Water Usage – 35,000 gallons
