NORTHERN DISTRICT

ATTEMPTED CAR JACKING

BROOKLYN PARK

On 4-10-08 at 1329 hours Northern District officers responded to the Shoppers Food Warehouse located at 5722 Ritchie Hwy in Brooklyn Park in reference to an attempted car jacking that just occurred. The victim, an elderly female, and a witness, who was seated nearby and observed the incident, gave a description. They described the suspect as a tall white male wearing a black or dark colored ball cap, and a black and gray horizontal striped shirt. Both verified that the male fled north on Morgan Rd towards Baltimore City. The description was relayed for a suspect broadcast. Officers canvassed the area thoroughly without success.

The victim stated that as she returned to her car parked on the side lot of Shoppers Food Warehouse, and started to close her driver's side door, a white male pulled the door open. He grabbed her by her left arm and stated, "Get out," and attempted to pull her from the vehicle. The victim stated that she started to scream and fought back with the suspect, eventually kicking him in the groin area. She concluded by stating that he fled north on Morgan Rd.

The witness stated that she observed the suspect as he was leaning against the west wall of 5718 Ritchie Hwy. She advised that she observed the male walked towards the parking lot in the direction of where the victim was parked. She heard the victim scream and the male run towards Morgan Rd.

Suspect: White male, tall, last seen wearing a black/ dark colored ball cap and a black/gray horizontally striped shirt.

ARMED ROBBERY

On 04/10/08, the Anne Arundel County Police Department responded to the Pizza Bolis, located at 300 Crain Hwy. N. Glen Burnie, for the report of a robbery. At approximately 2232 hours three unidentified black male subjects entered the business. All three male subjects displayed handguns; one of the suspects then demanded money. The suspects fled on foot with an unknown amount of U.S. Currency. Air, K-9 and officers responded to the area and conducted a search with negative results.

SOUTHERN DISTRICT

CDS/FIREARM ARREST

HILLSMERE

On April 10, 2008 at approximately 2334 hours, Detectives from Southern Districts P.A.C.T. Unit conducted a traffic stop at the intersection of Forest Drive and Hillsmere Drive after observing a traffic violation. After conducting a brief investigation, Detectives had the male driver exit the vehicle.

During a search of the vehicle, Detectives recovered a loaded .38 caliber handgun from underneath the driver's seat. A check through communications revealed the gun was stolen. In addition, Detectives located a large bag containing 44 baggie's of suspected heroin in the center console of the vehicle. A second medium sized bag containing 15 additional baggie's of heroin was located in the driver's pants pocket. The driver was arrested and his 1996 Chevy Caprice was seized.

Seized Evidence:

- 59 bags of Heroin (total weight of 30.3 grams) with an approximate street value of \$6,060.00.
- 1996 Chevy Caprice
- \$735.00 in US Currency (located on the suspect)
- Loaded (stolen) .38 caliber handgun
