ROBBERY

On 4-15-08 at 1839 hours, officers from the Northern District responded to 904 Amelia Ave. for the report of a strong-arm robbery. Upon arrival, the victim stated at approximately 1830 hours he was walking through the park located in the area of Goodwood Rd and Guildford Rd when he was approached by a group of individuals in there teen's. The victim indicated that the group of teens told him they were going to go through his pockets. When the victim turned around the group asked, "What are you looking at ". The victim said at this time he was physically assaulted by the group. He started fighting back when one of the teens, a black male wearing a brown shirt and blue jeans sprayed mace in his face. The group of teens went in his pockets and stole a Nokia cell phone and ten dollars. The group of teens fled the area on foot towards Gilford Rd. The victim said there were two black males and seven white males in the group of suspects. The victim only got a description of the one black male that sprayed him in the face with the mace. A search was conducted of the area with negative results. No further information at this time.

EASTERN DISTRICT

THEFT FROM AUTOS

SEVERNA PARK

On April 16, 2008, at approximately 0334 hours, officers of the Anne Arundel County Police Department, Platoon #4 of the Eastern District, were directed to the 700 block of Laurel Lane in Severna Park for a report of suspects tampering with automobiles.

Arriving officers stopped a vehicle on Benfield Boulevard after it was seen leaving the area of Laurel Lane. The two occupants of the vehicle were detained while additional officers spoke with residents on Laurel Lane to determine if anything had been stolen from their vehicles. Several of the residents reported that someone rummaged through their vehicles but nothing had been stolen.

The officers on the traffic stop searched the suspect vehicle for a possible controlled dangerous substance (CDS) violation. The search revealed a Tom Tom GPS unit and several credit cards that didn't match the names of the suspects. A further investigation revealed the GPS was stolen from a vehicle on Echo Bay Court in Gambrills and the credit cards were stolen from a vehicle on Ben Oaks Drive in Severna Park.

The suspects were identified as Blake Randall Schneider (18) of the 600 block of Hollywood Road in Severna Park and Paul Kalin Rozanski (18) from the 400 block of Highfield Court in Severna Park. Both suspects were charged with two counts of theft under \$500.00 and two counts of tampering with automobiles. Schneider was additionally charged with possession of CDS paraphernalia.
