STRONG ARM ROBBERY

PASADENA

On February 6, 2012, at approximately 8:18 p.m., officers from the Northern District responded to the area of Liberty Circle and Whitaker Road in Pasadena for a report of a citizen robbery.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with the victim, a 32-year-old male pizza delivery driver, who stated that he went on a delivery in the 7900 block of Liberty Circle, exited his vehicle and was approached by three male subjects on bicycles. At that time, one of the suspects pushed the victim into his open vehicle door while the other two suspects took the food from his possession. All three suspects then fled on their bicycles eastbound on Liberty Circle. Several officers and a K-9 unit searched the area, but were unable to locate the suspects.

Suspects: Three black males, approximately 17-18 years old, wearing all dark clothing

COMMERCIAL ARMED ROBBERY

GLEN BURNIE

On February 6, 2012, at approximately 7:41 p.m., officers from the Northern District responded to the Dunkin' Donuts located in the 7100 block of Ritchie Highway in Glen Burnie for a reported armed robbery of the business that had just occurred.

Upon arrival, officers learned that a male suspect entered the store, displayed a hand gun and threatened the clerk. The suspect then took an undisclosed amount of U.S. currency, fled to an unknown vehicle parked in an adjacent parking lot and headed northbound on Crain Highway. Responding Northern patrol officers canvassed the area, but were unable to locate the suspect.

Suspect: Black male, approximately 6'3", 200 pounds, wearing a black hooded jacket and black hat
