WESTERN DISTRICT

Homicide (UPDATE)

Laurel

On December 21, 2009, at approximately 1:46 a.m., officers from the Western District responded to the area of Red Clay Road and Route 198 in Laurel for a report of a sick or injured subject.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with a witness, who reported seeing the victim collapse in the middle of the roadway. Officers immediately observed the male victim, later identified as Jamal Medina, 22, of the 200 block of Red Clay Road in Laurel, Maryland, lying in the middle of Red Clay Road. The victim was suffering from apparent stab wounds to the upper body. Fire Department personnel transported the victim to Laurel Regional Hospital, where he was pronounced dead. Through the investigation and evidence collected at the scene, this incident appears to be a homicide. At this time, the suspect(s) and motive are unknown. The victim was transported to the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner in Baltimore so an autopsy could be performed and the cause and manner of death can be determined. (UPDATE)

On January 13th detectives from the Anne Arundel County Police Homicide Unit, assisted by Western District detectives and PACT officers, executed a search and seizure warrant at 336 Cokeland South in Laurel. While executing the search warrant, detectives recovered items of evidentiary value related to the case. Additionally, two female subjects located inside the residence were taken into custody. The women were transported to the Criminal Investigation Division and interviewed by Homicide detectives. (continued on page 2)

As a result of the investigation, both subjects have been charged with First degree Murder in the death of Jamal Medina.

On January 14th detectives obtained charges against her for three counts of Fourth Degree Sex Offense, which a misdemeanor.
