**Robbery**

On July 5, 2008 at approximately 11:57 pm, officers were dispatched to an Armed Robbery at 231 Mountain Road, Pasadena Maryland, 21122. The complainant, an off duty Anne Arundel County Police Officer driving his personal vehicle, advised that two males were standing on the parking lot of 8157 Waterford Road and began waiving him over as he traveled north on Waterford Road.

The two males approached the driver's side window. Suspect 1 remained at the driver's window as suspect 2 walked around the rear of the car to the passenger side window. Suspect 1 is described as a Hispanic male, approximately 5'5, 130- 150 pounds, shaved head with approximately a week's growth, no facial hair, wearing a white tank top. Suspect 2 is described as a Hispanic male wearing a black t- shirt and armed with a handgun. Upon approaching the vehicle, suspect 1 announced a robbery and demanded the officer turn over cash. After complying with the suspect's demands, suspect 2, armed with an unknown type of handgun, fired one shot into the vehicle. The shot missed the officer, but struck the interior side of the drivers door. After the robbery, the officer immediately called 911 to report the incident. The officer was not injured and did not discharge a firearm during the incident.

Both suspects fled on foot north on Waterford Road toward Mountain Road. Both suspects crossed Waterford Road and ran to the rear of 231 Mountain Road (E-Z Quick Mart) continuing west parallel to Mountain Road. A K-9, as well as numerous other officers, and a police helicopter responded to the scene, but no suspects were apprehended.

The officer is not being identified to ensure his safety. He is a one-year veteran of the Anne Arundel County Police Department and is assigned to the patrol division.
