ROBBERY ARRESTS

ANNAPOLIS

On May 24, 2009, at approximately 4:00 p.m., police responded to the 400 block of Blossom Tree Court in Annapolis for a report of an armed robbery that had just occurred.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with the victim, who reported that he had received a phone call from a known subject and walked to a nearby intersection to meet with him. At that intersection, the victim stated that he met the acquaintance and entered his vehicle. Once inside the vehicle, the victim stated that he was robbed at gunpoint by the acquaintance and another subject who had been hiding in the back seat. The victim advised that he fled from the vehicle, ran home and called the police.

Eastern District Detectives investigated the incident and developed two suspects. Warrants were obtained for the suspects and both were apprehended on June 1, 2009, and charged with Armed Robbery, Robbery, Theft over \$500, 1st Degree Assault and the Use of a Handgun During the Commission of a Felony.

On May 12, 2009, and May 28, 2009, members of Southern District's P.A.C.T. unit, with the assistance of a subject under the age of 21, conducted Operation S.A.V.E. (Selective Alcohol

ROBBERY

ANNAPOLIS

On June 1, 2009, at approximately 6:53 p.m., officers from the Southern District responded to East of Maui Surf Shop and Festival Organic Cleaners located in the 2300 block of Forest Drive in Annapolis for an armed robbery.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with the female victim, who reported that a male subject entered the Festival Organic Cleaners and approached the front counter. He then displayed a handgun and ordered her to open the register. The suspect left the store when the victim told him she had no money. Next, the suspect entered the East of Maui Surf Shop, displayed a handgun and ordered the employee of that store to open the cash register. He took an undetermined amount of U.S. currency and fled the area on foot. Numerous officers, a K-9 unit and an Aviation unit searched the area, but were unable to locate the suspect.

Suspect: Male, wearing black jeans, black t-shirt, black skull cap, sunglasses and a black bandana covering his face.
